

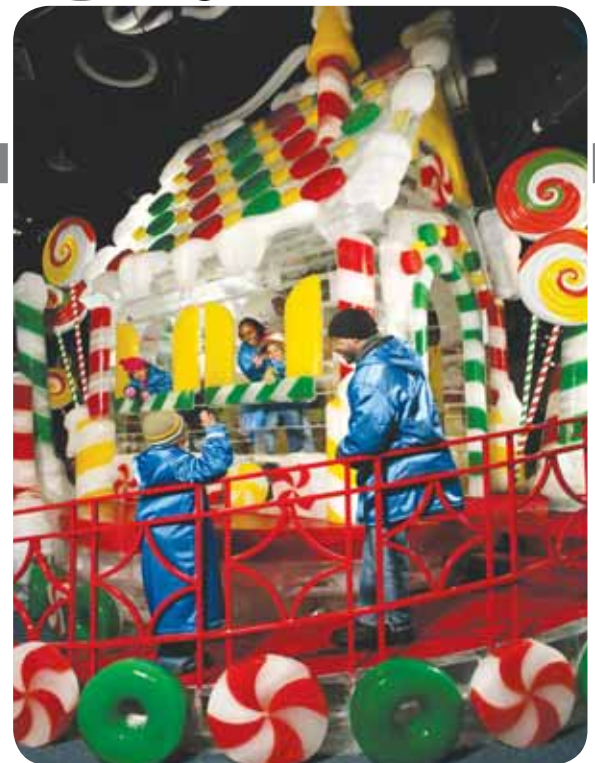

All carvings are housed in a custom-built structure maintained at a temperature of 9 degrees.
