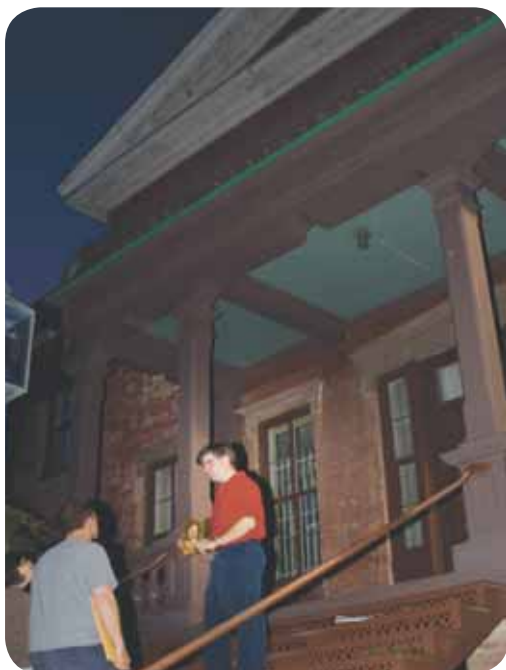
## A Literary Feast.
